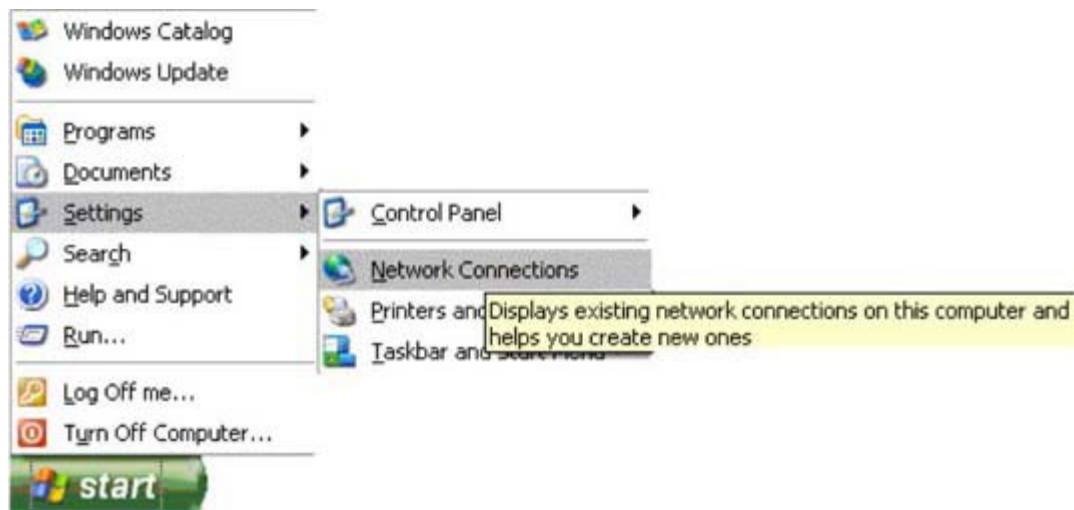


Configuring your Win XP Machine for DHCP

1. Go to Start Button.



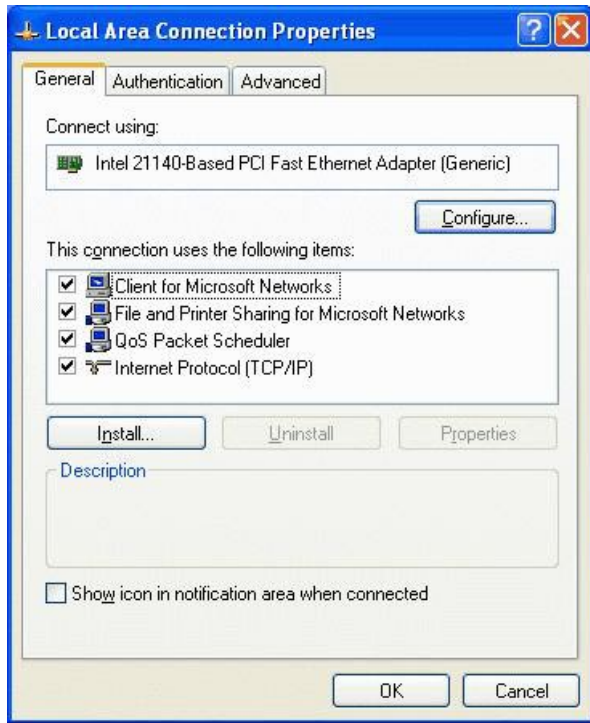
Go to the Start Button, then up to Settings, and across and down to Network Connections as shown above.

2. Open the Network Connections



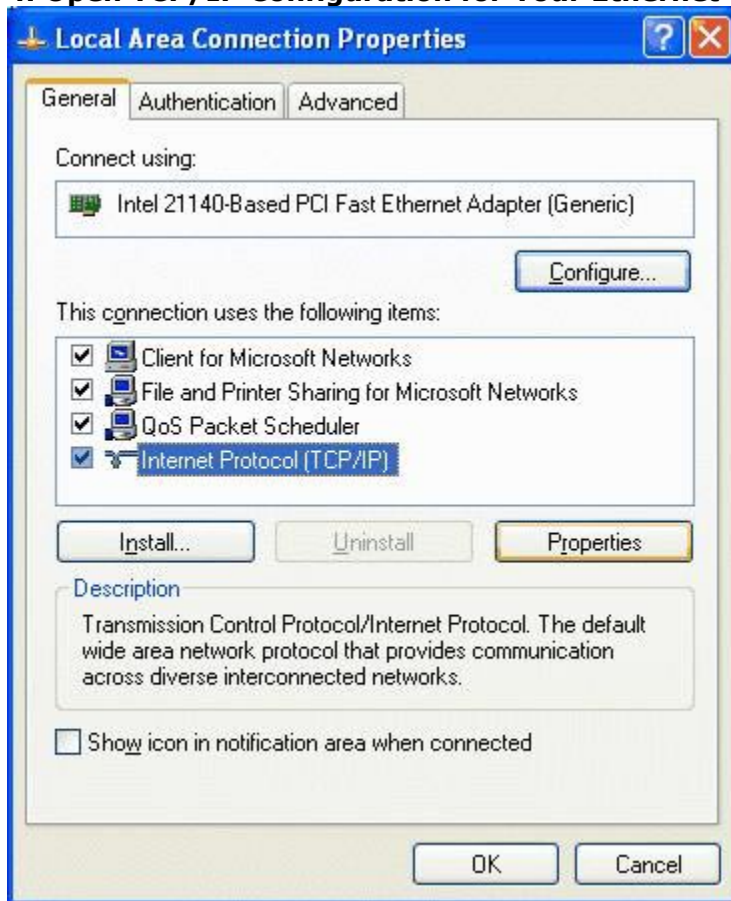
Right click on the icon that says "Local area Connections", then go down to and click on Properties.

3. Open the Local Area Connection Properties



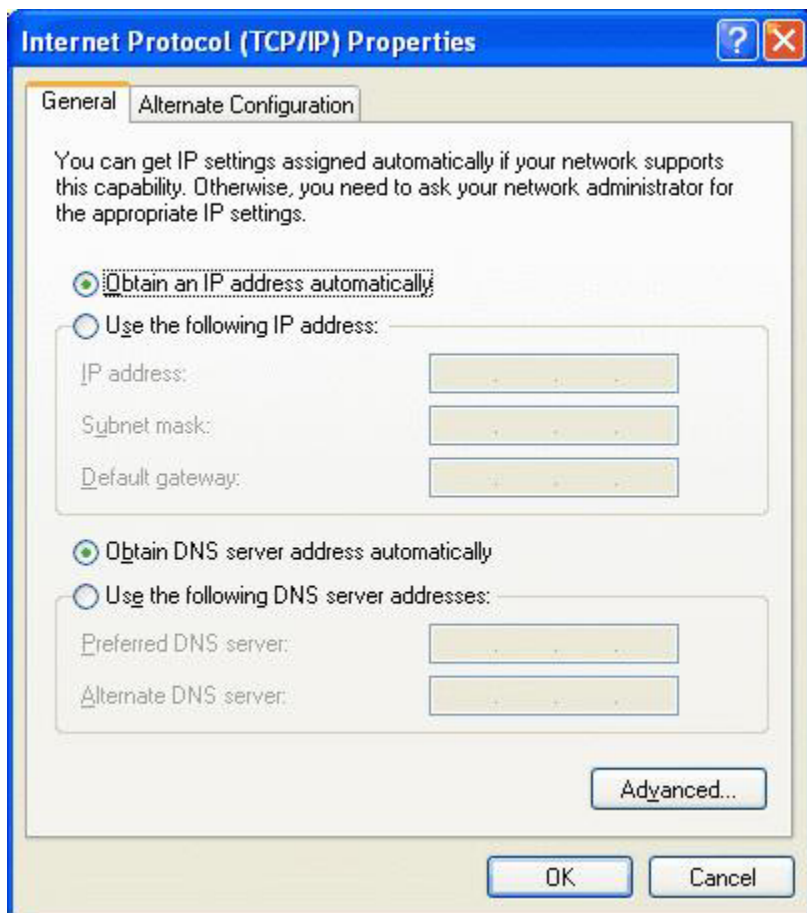
Single Click on the icon that says "Internet Protocol (TCP/IP) ".

4. Open TCP/IP Configuration for Your Ethernet



Click on the "Properties" tab. This is shown above

5. Obtain an IP Address Automatically



From the "General" tab, select "Obtain an IP address automatically" by clicking the appropriate radio button. You will also need to select "Obtain DNS server address automatically" by clicking the its radio button as shown above.

6. Make the Changes Take Affect

- Click OK on the "Internet Protocol (TCP/IP) Properties" screen.
- Click OK on the "Local Area Connection Properties" Screen.
- Click OK when asked to restart your computer.
